## **Ticket Distribution Details**

1. Tickets will be allocated, using the guidelines, outlined below, as agreed by the committee and Annual General Meeting of Killyclogher St Mary's GAC.

2. Elected committee members:- i.e. those people who have been elected at the club's AGM and club trustees, are entitled to two tickets each.

**3.** Club coaches, club workers, adult representatives – male and female, i.e. any adult member who has represented the club at adult level in any competition are entitled to one ticket each. **Tickets will be issued to those who qualify in 2 and 3 on the assumption that they are regular contributors to the club's weekly lottery / Cairde scheme.** 

4. The remaining tickets will then be distributed among fully paid up adult members, **who are regular contributors to the club's weekly lottery / Cairde scheme** and drawn by ballot if necessary.

5. Any remaining tickets will then be distributed to fully paid up members and also drawn by ballot if necessary.

6. Should any tickets remain then the allocation will then pass to minor members:- i.e those over 16 and under 18 using the same criteria and also drawn by ballot if necessary..

7. Application for tickets must be made in writing (Application forms are available at the Fitness Suite) or by email to <u>secretary.killyclogher.tyrone@gaa.ie</u> giving details of ticket requirements.

## **Important notes**

No one will be entitled to a **double allocation**. Excepting clause 2 all other members will be entitled to **one ticket only**.

Tickets are allocated on the basis that they are issued for the personal use of members and not to be passed on to friends or relatives who are not members of Killyclogher St. Mary's G A C.

Equally tickets are not to be passed on to persons who are not entitled to them under the allocation system outlined above.

The club will make every effort to acquire an allocation of youth tickets and allocation of these tickets will be the responsibility of the youth section.

Persons who are not members of Killyclogher St Mary's GAC will not be allocated tickets.

Tickets must be collected in person except where there is a verified reason for a nominated proxy to collect tickets. Tickets not collected by respective groups on the designated nights for distribution will be re-allocated and the assumption made that if a person is not present then he/she does not require a ticket.
